At First Tower School, we believe that Music gives children the opportunity to experience the world around them and express themselves in a variety of ways. We follow 'Charanga' to organise and plan our Music curriculum to ensure that children learn the knowledge and skills progressively, term on term and year on year as they move through the school.

At First Tower, learners have the opportunity to take part in a range of hands-on musical activities. Children can learn to play different musical instruments such as recorders, trumpets and ukeleles. Pupils learn to play these musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression, using and understanding musical notations with regular visits from the Jersey Music Services. Children can also join the school choir in Year 5 and 6.

Music is vitally important to develop children's creativity, imagination and improve their self-esteem and wellbeing. We do this through exploring famous musicians and composers to support the children in understanding what it means to be a musician.
