Religious Education









RE at First Tower links closely to the three key school values that underpin all teaching and learning at our school: respect, learn and persevere. Through teaching of RE, teachers inspire pupils to discover things about people from other cultures and religions different to their own. RE lessons at First Tower:

- -adopt an enquiry- based approach beginning with the children's own life
- -provoke challenging questions about the meaning and purpose of life, beliefs, the self, and issues of right and wrong, commitment and belonging.
- -develop pupils' knowledge and understanding of religions and religious traditions fostering personal reflection and spiritual development.
- -encourage pupils to explore their own beliefs (religious or non-religious.)
- -enable pupils to build their sense of identity and belonging
- -develop a sense of awe, wonder and mystery.
