Dear Parents and Carers,

This booklet outlines the school uniform requirements for First Tower School. Please note the following important points:

- Summer or Winter uniform may be worn during the first half of the Autumn term.
- Winter uniform should be worn from the second half of the Autumn term and during the Spring term.
- All pupils will be expected to wear Summer uniform in the Summer term.
- Coats should be black or navy, preferably with a hood *please remember that although you may travel by car, pupils may play or work outside during the day. Also pupils may make off site visits.* During the summer months pupils need to bring a plain, lightweight jacket into school as the weather is so unpredictable.
- Shoes should be black or navy with flat heels *trainers are to wear with P.E. kits only*. Fashion shoes, including shoes with heels, are un-safe for the school day.
- Trousers need to be of a standard type school trousers and not fashion trousers.
- Caps (or navy woolen hats in winter) are to be put in Book Bags to bring to school every school day. Caps should either be plain navy baseball caps or navy baseball caps with the school logo.
- Parents are respectfully reminded that in the interests of health and safety jewellery is restricted to a plain wristwatch (for Key Stage 2 pupils) and small, plain, non-dangly studs if pupils have pierced ears. Wearing one charity band has also been agreed.
- Long hair needs to be tied up for school and extreme styles, such as cut marks in hair, large amounts of gel, hair colour and large hair do-ups or lengths of beads are not appropriate as they tend to cause distraction to other pupils.
- Pupils wear their school P.E. kit, including track suits, on agreed P.E. days. Your class teachers will give you more information on this at the start of each year.
- Pupils only need the following: a school book bag and a standard lunch box if they stay for lunch.
- Finally, please remember to name <u>everything</u> in order to help us help your children take care of their property. Should items become mislaid they may be in the classroom lost property box. Items that are unnamed and cannot be returned will be donated to the Friends of First Tower second hand uniform shop.

By adhering to our policy you are helping us to encourage all our pupils to take a pride in their appearance and support our school community. This support also contributes towards raising the positive profile of our school and our attitude towards quality learning.
